**Proposal from Meaghan Stanton**

Meaghan has proposed a mountain bike interschool race in memory of George Drummer, a student from Oxley College who died recently. Meaghan spoke at the meeting. The committee agreed with the proposal. In summary:

SHCC would be the host club and run the race as an MTBA event. Day licences would be issued to provide insurance cover for participants.

The event would be held on **Sunday 22 November** at Welby. It would involve students from Oxley and Chevalier for this year. In future years it may involve other schools.

Meaghan would coordinate the event and liaise with Cam Cowan from Chevalier. The event would involve teams of 3 or 4.

First aid and a parking plan would need to be organized. Possibly toilets hired also.

Year 11 students from Oxley would act as parking marshals as part of their Community Service scheme.

There will be a follow up meeting with Meaghan and the SHCC committee on **Wed 4 Nov at 7pm** to clarify all the arrangements.
